Attached are the Profit & Loss reports for the month of September and October 1-15. September we had a loss of \$1,593.44 and for the first 15 days of October we had a loss of \$6,615.02.

From January 1 thru September 30 we have a total loss of \$37,987.38.

Our bank balances as of October 25th is \$211,266.14 plus our investments of \$103,687.74 for a total of \$314,953.88.

So, we had our last Elks game on Friday. So far, we have received a total of \$5,775.00 with a minimum of \$3,500.00 to come. Our possible bonus from the Elks is a minimum of \$2,360.00. This would go up as well with our sales.

I would like to thank Cde L Chittim for getting us the Elk's games and concerts and for organizing all volunteers to work the concession. I would also like to thank all the volunteers that worked the Elk's games and concerts this year.
