Financial Report – Cde J Vincent – Note: Income for the 75th anniversary was \$4,712.00, the cost was \$2,562.11. Profit and Loss reports for the months of August and September 1-15. In August, we had a loss of \$2,176.51 and for the first 15 days of September we have a loss of \$6,829.05.

From January 1 – August 31, we have a total loss of \$36,481.11. Our bank balances as of September 19th is \$203,502.11 plus our investments of \$103,532.40 for a total of \$317,034.51.

You will notice that I added an income account called Donations for Veterans House. This is the account to keep track of all monies that are donated either by swear jar or just cash

Cde B McKay – Co Treasurer/Casino/Fundraising – Thanks to everyone that has been selling Grey Cup books. Thanks to everyone for making it happen. This is my report, and I so move; seconded by Cde J Vincent. All in favour, opposed if any, carried.

Cde K Mulligan – Executive Assistant/Co Membership – After the meeting, could someone who has an event happening in October, please bring me a copy with the info so I can do the calendar and the table talkers for October. I really need all the events. This is my report, and I so move; seconded by Cde L Monson. All in favour, opposed if any, carried.

President's Report – Cde C Leger – Further to my report from the executive meeting, we are still waiting for parts for the kitchen cooler, and we bought a second cooler, which was very much needed when we cater for more than 50 people. Prior to the summer break, there was a motion made for a donation to Veterans House Canada for \$25,000. The motion was passed at the June general meeting. Initially, AGLC would not allow this donation to go through. Well, since then, Veterans House Canada challenged AGLC, and the request was reversed, and we are now allowed to donate those funds to Veterans House Canada to go towards the “Honour Wall”. We would like to thank the Ladies Auxiliary for their donation that will be used to pay for the cooler. This is my report, and I so move; seconded by Cde R Ram. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Cde C Leger – We had a request from the singles dart league for use of the facility on Wednesday nights, but due to their low enrolment it was not possible for us to have them here, so we declined their request. Still waiting to catch up with the property management. We now have access to the website, still learning the ins and outs. Improvements still to come. This is my report, and I so move; seconded by Cde S Power. All in favour, opposed if any, carried.

NEW BUSINESS

Cde R Evans – After further discussions about reinstatement of the funds for 699 Air Cadets and the funding they need to run the unit for 1 year, which is almost \$100,000 a year; any extra funds that they could acquire could be used to implement new programs and help with other parts of their program. With that said I move that we get funding through the poppy fund to support the 699 RCAC. Cde F Hutchings seconded this

motion. All in favour, opposed if any, carried. We will put together a request through the poppy fund for support.

Cde N Farren – I move that the Ladies Auxiliary be allowed to hold a Bake sale on December 5th from 6-9 and the 6th from 1-4. We will be holding a raffle draw called Christmas Cash – 1st prize is \$500, 2nd prize is \$250, and 3rd prize is \$100. Seconded by Cde B McKay. All in favour, opposed if any, carried.

Madam S Harnois presented an opportunity to advertise in “The SPANN ” that could bring in more members to the LA and the Branch. This needs to be done before Nov 10 with the final ad being ready for Nov 17. The LA has offered to pay all costs associated with this endeavour; seconded by Cde L Monson. All in favour, opposed if any, carried.

Cde B McKay – This is a great idea and a good opportunity for both the LA and the Branch. We can get both executives together to produce what we want in the ad.

Cde R Ram – I want to put a package together to welcome new members. I want it to include what the legion is all about, why they should be members of the legion and how they can take part. The motion is for a written package for new inductees into the legion and he is volunteering to coordinate it; seconded by Cde G McNaughton. All in favour, opposed if any, carried.

Cde B McKay – Great idea, put it on paper and bring it to the executive

Cde R Ram – How can we go about getting other people to open and close the legion, other than the same 2 people opening and closing all the time. Cde S Monson suggested that previous executive members could help. Cde C Leger suggested that it come back to the executive for discussion.

Cde F Hutchings – MP Billy Morin donated a pair of moccasins. The president will figure out what we will do with them.

Cde Brother B Gal – I am asking for your blessing to take on a new role with another organization. I am hoping that there is no conflict of interest. Cde C Leger and the members gave their blessings.
